## SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS:

Selection for scholarship awards are decided by recommendations of an independent committee of concerned Boston Educators / Residents that are not employed by the Boston Fire Department. Winners will be notified by phone or email etc. Criteria for selection of any scholarship award by the Vulcan Society is subject to review by the Executive Board and will be judged by Essay content.

The Boston Society of Vulcans are offering scholarships for \$2000.00 each to five <u>Boston Public</u> <u>High School Seniors</u> who are <u>Boston residents</u>, or the <u>sons & daughters of Vulcan members</u>. A maximum of two immediate family members / children of Vulcan members can receive the award. Eligible students who are selected by the scholarship committee must attend a 2 or 4 year college / university during the Fall 2024 - 2025 school year. The award will be given directly to the student in the Fall after registration confirmation and the school's add / drop period expires.

Lloyd Phillips, Raymond Moss and Robert Powell were Black Boston Firefighters and community & civic leaders. Lloyd Phillips served as a Boston firefighter and recruiter for many years. Raymond Moss served as a vocal activist for the equal treatment of all firefighters. Robert Powell was a founding member of the Vulcan Society and served as its first Chief Historian and a mentor for over thirty-five years. They were all deeply committed and interested in young adults who demonstrated an interest in the fire service and more importantly, an interest in their community through participation in civic activities. They encouraged young people to pursue careers in public safety along with a college education and they lived by the motto; "<u>All that I am, I owe</u>" (to those that came before me).

Prospective candidates are required to write an approximately 500 word essay (double spaced with 12 point font) that "Shares your major academic interest(s) and how you plan to pursue it / them in college. Also, explain what career path you're considering and how this scholarship helps you achieve it." Award recipients will be selected based on essay content.
