The award will be given directly to the student in the Fall after registration confirmation and the add / drop period expires.

Lloyd Phillips, Raymond Moss and Robert Powell were Black Boston Firefighters and community & civic leaders. Lloyd Phillips served as a Boston firefighter and recruiter for many years. Raymond Moss served as a vocal activist for the equal treatment of all firefighters. Robert Powell was a founding member of the Vulcan Society and served as its first chief historian and Dmentor for over thirty-five years. ~~N\~~ were DO deeply committed and interested in young adults who demonstrated an interest in the fire service and more importantly an interest in their community through participation in civic activities. They encouraged young people to pursue careers in public safety along with a college education and ~~W~~ lived by the PRWW\$OOOW,DP, RZ (to those that came beforeH).
